

Richmond Canoe Club Tours 2010

Guildford to Godalming Sunday 2 May

The 2010 touring season will begin with an exploration of the River Wey as it passes Guildford and meanders its way through beautiful Surrey countryside to the picturesque town, Godalming. The return trip is about 16 miles. We will meet at RCC at **8.30am** and return by about **5.30pm**. As usual, we will pool transport and make a **£10 (£5 for juniors)**, towards the cost of petrol, parking etc. Further information on the trip will be circulated nearer the time.

We need cars with roof racks that can be fitted with V-bars and carry one or two K2s. If you are coming on the trip and can help with transport please let Jim know.

Just to remind you, the tour group aims to explore new stretches of water, and different paddling challenges, with picnics, pub lunches, and cream teas. The group is open to everyone, but if you are new to the club you may want to check with your coach that the paddle won't be too challenging.
