Membership records are held on a computer database. Members have the right not to have their details so held and should advise the secretary accordingly. **RACK SPACES:** active members who have a private racing boat they wish to keep at the club as part of their regular training must contact the Harbour Master who will endeavour to allocate a space if available. Spaces in the boat house are presently very limited and boats should not be kept at the club without prior arrangement with the Harbour Master. Once space has been officially allocated, a sticker will be applied to each boat upon payment of the required fee. **Any unidentified boat found stored in the boathouse may be removed and disposed off without prior notice.**
