Starting just north of Macclesfield, the course is an anticlockwise circuit of the six canals making up the 96 mile Cheshire Ring. There are 92 locks and 5 tunnels to portage. For the relays, the course is divided into 19 sections, each averaging about 5 miles.

Classes

C1 or K1 all the way, C2 or K2 all the way, K1 two person relay, K2 four person relay, K2 or Double Tourer ten person relay, Any other reasonable form of relay. (ten person relay teams are to be made up of five pairs, each a senior plus a junior or female).

Entry fees

£10 per person when paid as £10 deposit per boat before April 29th and the balance by June 15th £15 per person (by June 15th) if not secured by a deposit £20 per person between June 15th and June 25th (plus £2 per person for non members of the British Canoe Union) Entries are limited, book early to avoid disappointment
