Acceptance is not guaranteed so please ensure you have alternative racking arrangements should your application not be successful.

**IMPORTANT**

Spaces in the clubhouse are limited and allocation is conditional to the boat being used on a regular basis to take part in club training sessions and/or races. Spaces are allocated for a 12 months period and will be renewed at the beginning of each membership year at the discretion of the Harbour Master and upon payment of the racking fee in vigour.

Boats for which payment has not been received by 1<sup>st</sup> February of each year (i.e. 3 months after start of the club Membership Year) will be deemed abandoned and rack space reallocated. Richmond Canoe Club will endeavour to contact the boat owner but boats for which fees are still outstanding after 12 months will become club property and may be sold or used as club boats.

Boats are left at the owner's own risks and the club will not be held liable for damage, loss or theft.
